The changes from the previous reporting year for n-Butyl Acetate and Heptane were due to decreased production levels. Acetone decreased due to a formulation switch to water-based glue part way through the year (acetone is still contained in many of the surface coatings used at the facility).

Reduction Plan Objectives and Targets:

Although Decor-Rest does not intend to reduce the use of acetone, n-butyl acetate or heptane, they will continue to conduct further research to identify new reduction options and to keep up with industry standards with regards to pollution prevention.

Progress on TRA Plan:

No amendments were made to the Toxic Reduction Act Plans.

Additional Actions and their Impact on Substance Use, Creation and Discharge:

Acetone decreased due to a formulation switch to water-based glue part way through the year.
